

Chain Maille 4 in 1 with Pewter Rings

Supplies: (for 6mm ring kit)
84 to 100 pewter rings 6mm
42 to 50 silver aluminum jump rings 18g 3/16ö
3 silver aluminum jump rings 18g 5/32ö
1 pewter toggle set

Tools: 2 prs flat nose pliers

1. Open jump ring and pick up 4 pewter rings. Close Jump ring.



2. Lay Jump rings flat so that top of jump ring is on the right.



3. Open a second jump ring and link it through the two pewter rings on the right side of the group. Both ends of the jump ring should be facing up. Place one pewter ring on one side of the open jump ring and a second pewter ring on the other open end of the jump ring. Close jump ring.

4. Repeat step 3 until piece is 1/2ö short of desired length.



5. Attach 1 small jump ring to final jump ring in the piece and attach ring end of toggle.



6. Attach 1 small jump ring to other end then add a second small jump ring and the toggle.



* colored jump rings are used for photos to make steps more clear. The finished piece uses only silver jump rings.

Chain Maille 4 in 1 with larger Pewter Rings and variations

Supplies: (for 8mm ring kit)

66 to 74 pewter rings 6mm

33 to 37 silver aluminum jump rings 18g 3/16ö

7 silver aluminum jump rings 18g 5/32ö

1 pewter toggle set

Tools: 2 prs flat nose pliers



Variation #1

Make 4 in 1 in the same way as previous instructions. Because these rings are larger, you will need to stabilize the last 4 rings on each end to keep them from folding in.



Variation #2

Instead of needing a toggle, use rubber orings throughout the bracelet to give it stretch. Below I used 7.25mm orings on every 3rd row.



Variation #3

See Shaggy Loop Chain instructions. These same jump rings and pewter rings make a wonderful shaggy loop as well as the 4 in 1.



Supplies: (for 8mm ring kit)

52 to 60 pewter rings 6mm

26 to 30 silver aluminum jump rings 18g 3/16ö

26 to 30 black orings 7.25mm

Tools: 2 prs flat nose pliers
