

Dimensional Flower Chain Maille Bracelet

Supplies:

16 Orings-dusky teal 7.25mm
16 Orings-blueberry 12mm
16 Orings-raspberry ice 12mm
8 Jump Rings-purple 16g 1/4"
32 Jump Rings-silver ice 16g 1/4"

Tools:

2 prs Flat Nose Pliers
1 pr Long Needle Nose Pliers

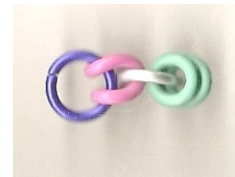


1. Before starting, close all purple jump rings and open all silver ice jump rings.

2. Pull 12mm Raspberry Oring half way through purple jump ring and hook a silver jump ring to both ends of the raspberry oring to keep it in place.



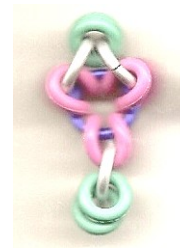
3. Place 2 dusky teal orings onto the silver ice jump ring and then close the jump ring.



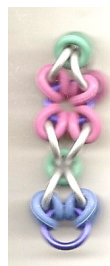
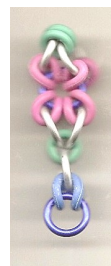
4. Pull a second raspberry oring through the original purple jump ring. Hook a silver ice jump ring through just as in step 2, pass through the 2 dusky teal orings already in place from step 3.



5. Repeat steps 2, 3 and 4 on the other side of the original purple jump ring



6. Pull 12mm Blueberry Oring half way through purple jump ring and hook a silver jump ring to both ends. Attach the silver ice jump ring to dusky teal orings from previous row. Repeat with a 2nd blueberry oring.



7. Repeat steps 2 and 3 on this ring using blueberry orings.

8. Continue pattern until you have 4 raspberry and 4 blueberry flowers. To finish, connect the last 2 blueberry orings to the beginning set of dusky teal orings.
